Modified Ambrose Rules of Play

Teams of 4 players

Each player plays their own ball from the tee, and the best-positioned ball is selected. The other players then play their next shot from this position. The player whose shot is used misses the next shot. This format continues until the ball is holed out.

Handicapping System

Team Handicaps have been calculated as follows: (1/8 of the aggregate for a 4-person team) and recorded on your team card. A player's approved handicap must reflect his/her actual playing ability. Max. Men's Handicap 27, Max, Ladies Handicap 36.

RULES

Distance from selected ball

Distance within which players may play their ball from the selected shot is one club length on the fairway, dropped within a club length in the rough or a putter head on the green.

Two Tee Shots

Each team member's tee shot must be used at least two (2) times per eighteen (18) hole round. The Scorer must record whose tee shot was used on each hole.

Course Tees

The tees to be used are marked White - for men and Red – for ladies.

Fore caddying

No player or spectator associated with a participating team is permitted to take up 'forward' positions on a hole to provide advice or assistance to team members.

Standing on an extension of line of play

Team members may stand behind one another while hitting a shot or putting.

Winning Team

The winning team will have the lowest nett score (Gross off the stick score minus team handicap).

The Countback system to be used, if required, is based on the lowest stroke score per hole commencing from the last hole (Island #9) and going backwards until a difference in scores of those in the countback is found

INSTRUCTIONS

Scorecard

The scorecard must show each team member's handicap. The scorecard is to be signed by the marker and countersigned by one other member of your team. Team scores are to be recorded and tallied.
